- **Supports Installation:** Install pipe supports, ensuring appropriate spacing to prevent excessive vibration.
- **Spur Line Laying:** Install the new piping from the Buffer Tank outlet to the Main Storage Tank inlet, including necessary valves for isolation.

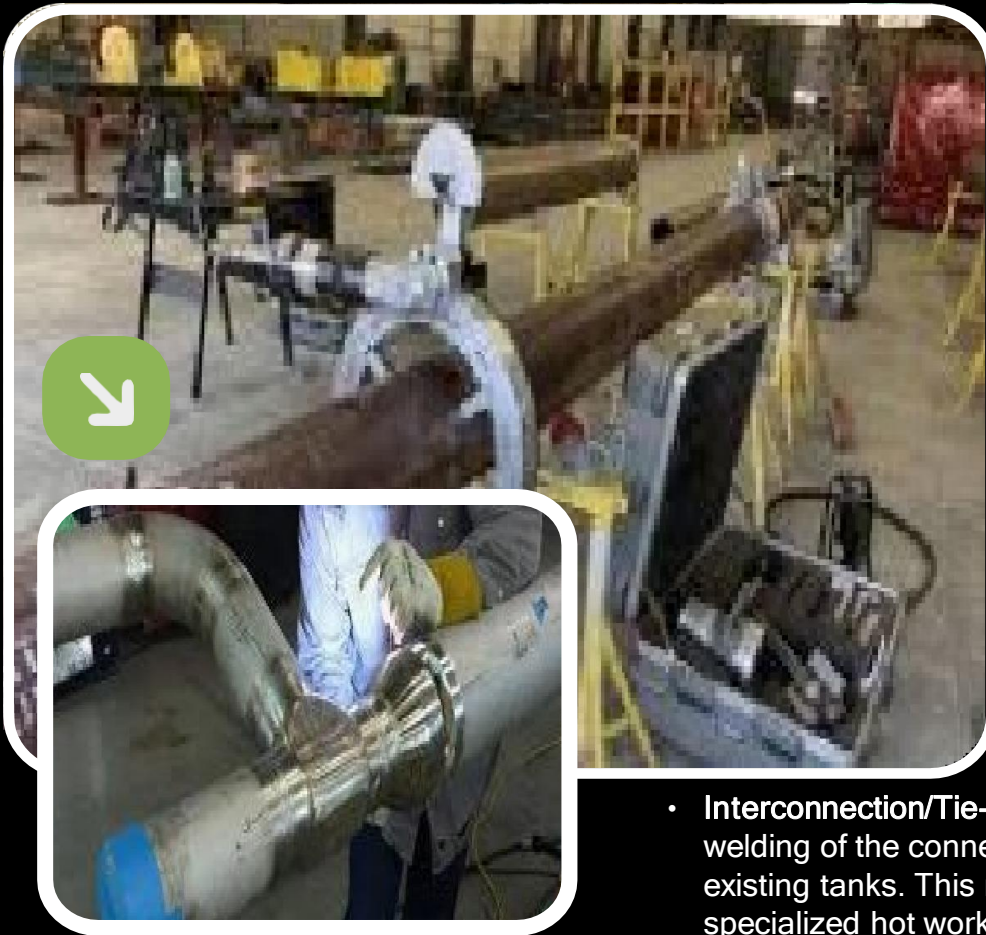
- **Interconnection/Tie-in:** Perform cutting and welding of the connection points on the existing tanks. This requires cold cutting or specialized hot work precautions (purging/inerting with Nitrogen) to ensure safety

Inspection and Testing (QA/QC)

- NDT (Non-Destructive Testing) to include Dye Penetrant Test (DPT) and Hydrotesting (Pressure tests the new spur line using water to 1.3 or 1.5 times the design pressure to ensure integrity).
- Leak Test: Perform a soap bubble test on all joints at operating pressure after nitrogen purging
- Cleaning, Coating, and Commissioning
- Cleaning and Painting for corrosion protection
- Purge the new line with Nitrogen to remove air before introducing LPG
- Commissioning: Gradually introduce LPG into the line, check for leaks, and handover to operations
- Submit As-built drawings, Welding logs and NDT reports, Hydrotest certificates, Material test certificates (MTCs) and Signed-off ITP (Inspection and Test Plan)

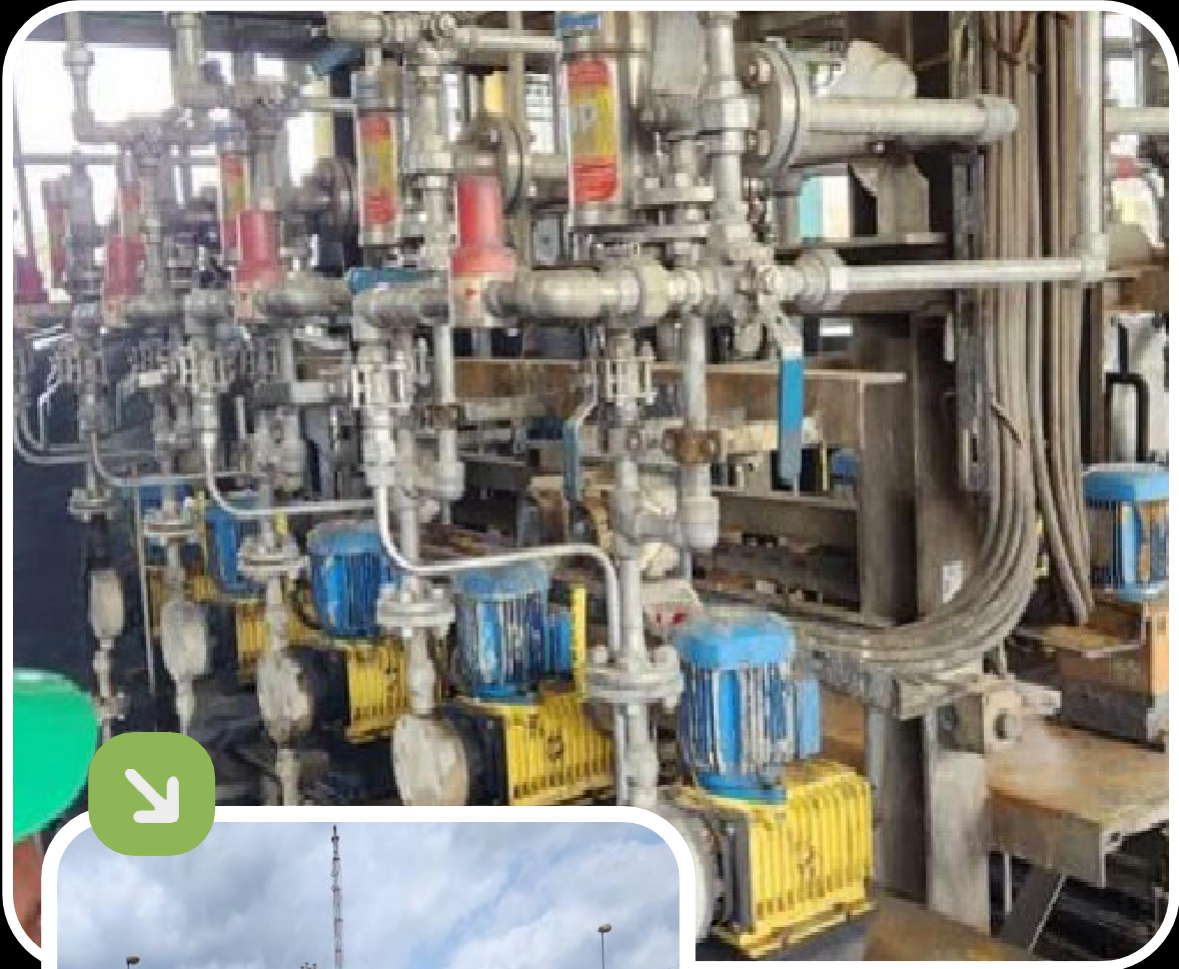

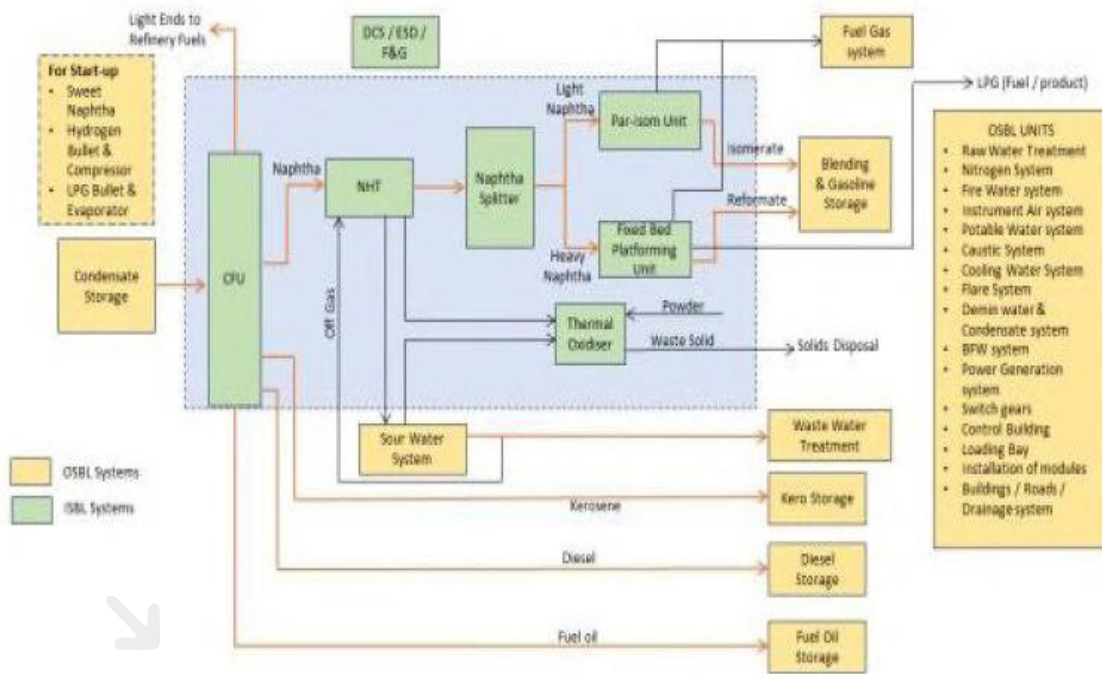
